



SAMSUNG International Pairs EGYPT is not only the largest and only Club competition of its kind in the EGYPT, but is the largest in the world. It offers every Golf Club member in the country the chance to represent their club with the very real possibility of making it through to the WORLD FINAL where they will take on like-minded golfers from over 30 countries in 6 continents.

How do I enter?

Every club member in Egypt with official handicap can enter any of the four qualifying rounds. Club employees are not permitted to compete. If you should not qualify from the first round that you enter, you may enter other qualifying rounds, with the appropriate payment for that event **HOWEVER – you will be only be allocated a space, in the event of first time players, not filling the draw, which will be decided after closing date for entries. Your name will be placed on a waitlist and advise by the club when you are in. The clubs controls the field size.** You may enter with a different partner, but as you as an individual have played before, you will still go on waitlist. You may not enter with a different playing partner. You can check our Calendar of Events here. Each event is run as a club event and entries are taken in line with usual club procedure.

ALL OF THE FOUR QUALIFYING ROUNDS ARE OPEN TO ALL PLAYERS – NOT ONLY MEMBERS OF THAT CLUB

Who can enter?

Anyone with a valid and verified handicap who is a member of the club holding the qualifying event is welcome. Pairings can be mixed, gent / gent or lady / lady

Is there an age limit?

Yes players must be 18 years or over at the date of the qualifying round.

Can I play in more than one round?

Yes, if you fail to qualify in any round you may enter

If I am a member of more than one club can I play in more than one qualifying event?

Yes! If you play in and win two or more events with the same or different partner, your first win will stand and the pair who finish runner-up at the second and / or subsequent events will qualify.

How much does it cost?

Club Qualifying event:- these are costed and charged by each club.

The National Final:- green fees, cart fees, giveaway, breakfast and lunch included in the Final

The World Final: Economy class tickets, green fees, hotel accommodation and official event meals will be provided

What is the format of play?

International Pairs is played with the same format worldwide from club qualifying events right through to the World Final, which is Pairs Betterball, $\frac{3}{4}$ Handicap.

Is there a Handicap limit?

Yes, the limit for gents is 24 and ladies is 28. $\frac{3}{4}$ handicap allowance is then taken from this handicaps. Players with higher handicaps may enter but they will play off the maximum.

How are prizes allocated in Club Qualifying events?

Prizes will be awarded to the top-3 pairs. There will also be hole prizes at each event. Each player will receive a giveaway at each qualifying round. Prizes are courtesy of event sponsor - SAMSUNG

What happens if I win my Club Qualifying event but am no longer a member of that club at the time of the National or World Final?

You will still qualify to play and will still represent that club. You must ensure, however, that you have a valid and verified handicap held by a new club. If you don't have the spot will be allocated to the next ranked pair.

Can a player be substituted prior to the National or World Final?

No. In the event that one of the players is unavailable, the place will be offered to the pair who were runners-up.

What can I do if I am not a member of a club in the Egypt?

Unfortunately you cannot compete this year.

Will all clubs have qualifying events?

The intention for 2013/2014 season is to having qualifying rounds at every club.
